Licking Summer Camps 2009

We are excited to announce that our *Licking Summer Camps* will enter its 16th year this summer with 15 camps, seven in basketball and 8 in volleyball, to be held in 7 locations throughout Missouri and Illinois. *Last year's program attracted over 14,000 athletes from 817 schools from a six state area. The camps are exclusively for junior high and high school girl's teams.*

We will once again use the **Rolla, MO** area as home base for our camps. We will in the Summer of 2009, host 8 camps in Rolla. The area's central location, easy highway access, numerous motels and restaurants, and overall friendliness; has created what many past campers have fondly referred to over the years as "the Rolla Experience." Don't forget the area's numerous fine floating streams. Many teams stay over an extra day to make a relaxing float the "icing on the cake" for their summer camp adventure. **We can make your floating arrangements for you at the lowest price on the river.** We will once again utilize the outstanding facilities at the Missouri University of Science and Technology, the Rolla Public Schools, the St. James Public Schools and the "awesome" courts at the Rolla Centre. The Splash Zone Water Park will again be available for our always popular Friday Night Swim.



For the fourth year we will host a basketball camp at Fox High School in **Arnold, MO**. Arnold is located at the southern edge of the St. Louis metropolitan area, adjacent to Interstate 55. All the facilities that we utilize are within easy driving distance and all facilities are air conditioned. The venues will once again be Fox High School and Middle School, Seckman High School and Middle School; along with state of the art facilities at the Arnold Community Center and the Arnold First Baptist Church. Camp Director will be Joe Salsman, Athletic Director of Fox High School.

Lincoln High School in **Lincoln, IL** will be for the third year the site of one of our two

Illinois volleyball camps. This growing community is located on I-55 between Bloomington, IL and Springfield, IL. The county seat of Logan County, the city has a population of 15, 418. The proximity to a major north-south interstate highway makes Lincoln a commercial hub for the Central Illinois area. The interstate highway also fosters the growth of the town's many fine restaurants and motels. Small town service, along with ample lodging and eating establishments, makes Lincoln, IL an ideal host site for our summer camps. We expect this camp to provide a central location that will attract outstanding teams from the St. Louis and Chicago areas. We will use the courts of the Lincoln Community schools, and will have access to several college venues, if needed. Camp Director Coach Dawn Crawford is in her first year as Head Coach at Lincoln and the highly successful Railsplitters have not missed a beat under her leadership.



Our **Branson, MO** volleyball camp, in its third year, is quickly growing into one of our most popular offerings and it is easy to see why. The end of July date will give coaches that all important last chance to evaluate their team before the start of fall practice. For many obvious reasons, the Branson

Area is a great venue for a summer camp. The Branson/Lakes Area has over 18,000 lodging units ranging from four star resorts where gourmet breakfast is served to guests as they watch the sun rise over Table Rock Lake, to establishments on world famous Hwy. 76 complete with swimming pools, water parks, miniature golf courses and family-style restaurants. To counter traffic problems, this year's camps will be held in one location utilizing the beautiful new facilities at Branson High School. Jeff Wead, head coach of the Branson Pirates, will direct the camp.

Bismark High School will serve as the host site of our **Farmington, MO** volleyball camp. Farmington is located on the US Highway 67 corridor, an easy one hour drive from the St. Louis area.



Much like Rolla, the Farmington area offers numerous and adequate motel and eating establishments, along with the safety and friendliness of small town hospitality. Facilities for this camp are outstanding. Our visiting athletes will compete at the brand new Bismark High School courts, the gyms of the Farmington and Park Hills Public schools and the Field House located on the campus of Mineral Area Community College. This area is a hot bed for high school volleyball and has proved to be one of our most competitive camps. The camp director for the third year will be long time successful Bismark Coach Paula AuBuchon.

We are adding two new sites to our 2009 lineup. On June 26-27, we will host a volleyball camp in **Quincy, IL**. The Blue Devils of Quincy High, under the leadership of head coach Barb Crist, have become a dominant force in Illinois volleyball. Coach Crist will serve as our camp director. Quincy is a great sports town with excellent event venues and a more than adequate supply of reasonable priced restaurants and motels. Our second new site will be the **St. Louis Sports Center**. We will host a volleyball camp at the brand new all air conditioned 8 court facility on June 19-20 and will close the summer camp season with a basketball camp on July 31-August 1. The Sports Center is confidentially located off of Interstate 55 in the south St. Louis Metro area.
